

Border Liners Easter Egg-O 2018

31st March to end of April



- Location: Crosby Garrett Fell
- Parking: Roadside verges along the minor road north or south of Mazon Wath. ***Sensitive verges – please park thoughtfully!***
- Map: Howgill Fells and Upper Eden Valley 1:25000
- Compass: Recommended but not essential.
- Start: NY 692 084 Ancient cairn.
- Courses: Long 9km 260m height gain 10 controls including cache
Short 7km 230m height gain 9 controls including cache
- Terrain: Open fell, tussocky in parts but generally dry underfoot.
- Cache: Chocolate, of course! Whilst munching, please record your walk/run in the notebook.
- Other comments: ***Dogs must be kept under close control; it is lambing season.***
A stream crossing is necessary on both long and short courses.
Electric fences cross parts of the area – please use the gates and crossing points provided.
- Open: from Saturday 31st March until the end of April.

You orienteer at your own risk. Let someone know where you are going.

Eggstra Information!

Some of you may not have done an Egg-O, so here is some extra information:

The Egg-O is a low-key affair, using open access areas so no need for landowners permission, fees etc.

You're looking for controls which are tent poles with yogurt pots taped on top. Directions to the next control are written as a 6 figure grid reference and a description, so a pencil or marker could be useful. The controls are deliberately inconspicuous but should be on easily identified features. Last control has chocolate. You may be the only person out and following the route, so look after yourself.

On a good day the views are excellent.
