

Final Details for Talkin Tarn

Date: Saturday 7th December 2019

Venue: Talkin Tarn, Nr Brampton CA8 1HN Grid ref: NY 545590

Nearest town: Brampton

Parking: Approach from the B6413 south of the town of Brampton. Large car park. Charges apply. £1.20 for one hour, £2.25 for above one hour, £4.50 for minibuses.

Map: 1:5000 2.5m contours.

Terrain: Open fields and woodland around a tarn. There is livestock in some fields (sheep). Please do not climb over any fences. Please shut all gates you open.

Registration from 10.30am. In the car park.

Starts: from 11am - 12noon, courses close 1.30pm

Courses:

Yellow (1.6 km 20m) a short circuit in woodland and fields suitable for beginners and children.

Primary children from Carlisle and Eden schools who take part on this course will also be eligible for entry into the Border Liners Schools Competition (see details below).

Light Green (3.2 km 80m) suitable for more experienced and who would like a longer run around the Tarn.

Green (3.2 km 80m) same route as the Light Green, but more technical with no paths marked on the map.

Carlisle and Eden Schools Competition

Primary children from Carlisle and Eden primary schools who take part in the Yellow course will also be eligible for entry into the Border Liners Schools Competition 2019. Enter when you register on the day. The best four results will decide the winning school. There is no limit to the number of entries from a single school. The winning school will be offered a visit from a World Champion orienteer and all children in the winning school who take part in the orienteering will be presented with a certificate.

Entry Fees: Entry on the day only.

Safety: The area includes a large area of water which is deep. The Yellow course is a short circuit of woodland and fields which goes around part of the Tarn. Please keep close supervision of any younger children. Be mindful of other users.

DOGS ALLOWED. Please be mindful of other runners and young children. Dogs are permitted but please see signage in the car park for details of the dogs on leads zone between the boathouse and the café area.

Facilities: There is a cafe and toilets at the north end of the Tarn.
